



Call it our healthy habit.
For the fourth year,
we asked more than
3,000 of the city's
doctors one question:

“If you had to refer a loved one to a local doctor other than yourself, to whom would you refer them?”

We counted only original ballots and online entries (doctors had to use their medical identification numbers to gain access to our site). No faxes or photocopies were accepted, and ballots received after the deadline were not counted.

Here are the more than 800 doctors that Albuquerque physicians consider “tops” in more than 30 medical specialties.
